July book sale was a great success

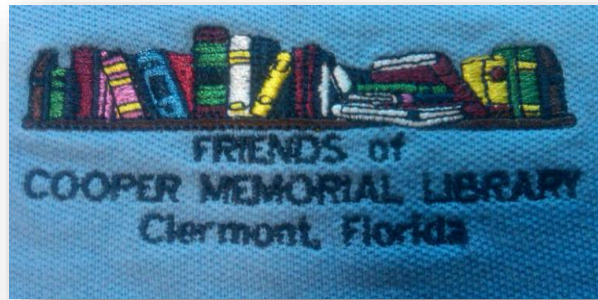
Thanks to everyone who turned out to browse and buy, the book sale resulted in over \$6000.00 in funds to be used by the "Friends" to continue supporting programs and events that

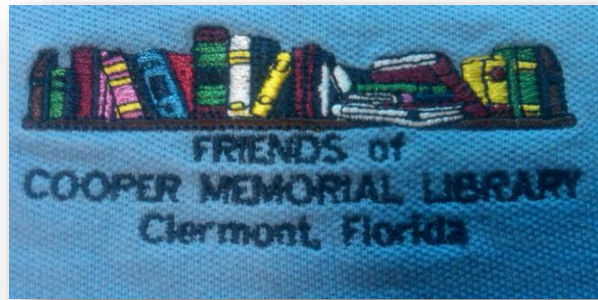
Discover New Orleans

may inspire others to become members as well.

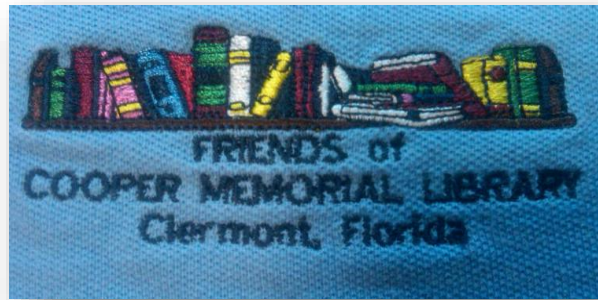
Meet the president.
